

ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must be a son or daughter of an owner, manager, or employee who is working in the business or shop of a tire dealer or automotive service facility.
- The student can be a current employee of the associate member.
- The business must be a LTASA member in good standing.
- The applicant must be a graduating high school student or presently enrolled in an accredited college or vocational school.
- The applicant cannot be a former recipient of the LTASA Scholarship.
- The student may complete the application before he or she has been notified of acceptance at the school of choice. However, to be eligible, applicants must be accepted at an accredited college, university, or vocational school.

Awards will be made on the basis of student character, citizenship & scholastic ability. The LTASA Scholarship Committee will determine the number of scholarships to be awarded. Awards will be announced by the LTASA Board of Directors. Checks will be payable to the student.

The LTASA College Scholarship was created to honor those students who have achieved academic excellence and who have proven community leadership abilities by awarding them a scholarship to the accredited college or vocational school of their choice.
